A FOUR-DAY EXCURSION TO

SANTORINI(Akrotiri and Ancient Thera)

to be conducted by Professor Christos Doumas and Dr. Stavros Paspalas

on Friday 31st May, Saturday 1st June, Sunday 2nd June and Monday 3rd June 2013

We are very happy to announce a four-day tour to Santorini, where we shall visit the world-famous sites of **Akrotiri** and **Ancient Thera**. We shall stay in Fira, the main town of the island that is built along the edge of the volcanic caldera.

Akrotiri, the amazingly well-preserved Bronze Age town engulfed by an ancient explosion of the island's volcano (c. 1600 BC) has been under systematic excavation for nigh on half a century. It is primarily known for its well-preserved architecture and its intriguing wall paintings. A number of years ago the site was re-opened to the public, though an unfortunate accident led to its closure soon afterwards. A few months ago the site, now protected under a newly-erected state-of-the-art shelter, was again opened to visitors. The Friends of the AAIA are *unbelievably fortunate* in being able to offer a guided tour over the site which will be conducted by **Professor Christos Doumas**, the **excavator of Akrotiri** since 1974. We will all benefit from the insights that Professor Doumas will share with us.

We shall also visit the site of Ancient Thera, the main settlement of the island during the Archaic through to the Early Byzantine periods, and one of the most important poleis of the southern Cyclades in Archaic and Classical times. A little-visited site, as it lies—metaphorically— in the shadow of Akrotiri, Ancient Thera has much to reward its visitor. Perched at an altitude of 360 m. above sea level on Mesavouno the well-preserved ruins offer an introduction to urban island life in antiquity. Dr. Stavros Paspalas will guide us over Ancient Thera.

Many of the finds made both at Akrotiri and Ancient Thera are on display in Fira. Those of the former at the Museum of Prehistoric Thera, and those of the latter at the Thera Archaeological Museum. Visits to these museums are included in the programme, and Dr. Paspalas will be present to answer any questions.

The projected itinerary is:

Friday May 31

07:30 Depart Peiraieus with Super Jet. Participants are asked to be at the boat no later than 07:10.

11:50 Arrival at Santorini (transfer to Pelican Hotel/

Costa Marina Hotel, Fira).

Afternoon / evening At leisure. Suggestion: visit to Megaron Gyzi Museum for an introduction to Santorini's mediaeval and more recent history, and stroll through beautiful Fira.

Saturday June 1

10:00 Visit to Thera Archaeological Museum (walking distance from hotel).

11:30 Board bus and make way to Ancient Thera.

12:00 Tour of Ancient Thera.

14:00 Oia for lunch (meal not included in package).

17:00 Wine tasting at Santo Vineyards, *Pyrgos* (on top of Caldera).

Evening At leisure in Fira.

Sunday June 2

10:00 Visit Prehistoric Thera Museum (walking distance from hotel)

11:30 Board bus and make way to Akrotiri.

12:00 Tour of Akrotiri

14:00 Return to Fira

Afternoon / evening At leisure in Fira. Suggestion: visit to the Folklore Museum in a traditional nineteenth-century cave house in Kontohori, Fira.

Monday June 3

10:00 Check out from hotel. Morning free in Fira.

12:55 Transfer to port. Depart on Super Jet for Peiraieus.

18:50 Arrival at Peiriaeus.

Members (plus one guest) who wish to participate in this excursion are requested to book their place and pay a non-refundable €130 deposit by Thursday April 25, at the very latest.

Non-Members are also requested to register their interest by the same date.
