

UNISA Classics Colloquium Pretoria 25-27 October 2012

CONFERENCE INFORMATION

Dear colleagues and friends

The following information pertains to the upcoming 13th Unisa Classics Colloquium:

Registration form

A registration form is attached. Please complete and return to me as soon as possible, but by 15 September at the latest.

Travel details and transport

- A shuttle will run from the OR Tambo International Airport to Pretoria on the morning of Wednesday, 24 October.
- In order to meet you at the correct terminal/arrival hall, we need your flight details please complete in full on the registration form. One of the organizers (or a shuttle driver) will meet you at the terminal where you exit (A or B). The terminal exits may be crowded, so please look around carefully for somebody holding up your name and/or 'Unisa Classics Colloquium'.
- If you arrive at any other time, we recommend you taking the train to Pretoria. The Gautrain runs regularly between the airport and Pretoria, but only until 20:30. A card can be bought at the airport. Single trip: R135-00.
- Please ensure that your passport is in order before leaving, especially regarding visas (if required) and the required number of blank pages.
- During the conference, you will be picked up at the guest house in the morning and dropped off in the afternoons. Unfortunately, picking you up at any other accommodation apart from the recommended Brooklyn Guest Houses is logistically difficult.
- Transport for the excursions is also included in the conference package.
- Shuttles back to the airport will be organized for Saturday (27th) at 14:00, Sunday (28th) at 18:00 and Monday (29th) at 13:00.



Accommodation

We have made preliminary bookings at the Brooklyn Guesthouses for speakers who indicated
that they require accommodation. The deluxe room (single) tariff for group bookings is R625
pppn, including breakfast. There are a limited number of smaller rooms available. You are

State that you will be attending the Unisa Classics Colloquium.

- If you wish to only attend the colloquium and stay at the guest house, you can book personally or indicate that on the registration form.
- Except for invited speakers, everybody is responsible for paying her/his own account before departure.
- The Brooklyn Guest Houses are in a quiet neighbourhood adjacent to the main campus of the University of Pretoria and a few minutes' walk from two smallish shopping malls (Hillcrest Boulevard; Brooklyn Mall see Google Maps).

Weather

We usually have fine weather in Pretoria during October, with lows around 16, highs up to 31 degrees and possible afternoon showers (it once rained throughout the conference). There is a pool at the guesthouse for those who would like a splash in the afternoon or early morning. The jacarandas are in bloom, so bring along your camera.

Money

You may bring traveller's cheques, but may also choose to withdraw cash from local ATMs; just inquire from your local bank if your PIN will be working in South Africa. There is an ATM on the Unisa Muckleneuk campus during the conference.

Conference fee

The conference fee (R1000) is payable at registration, either Wednesday evening or Thursday morning, in cash (South African currency please).

Communication

- The guesthouse has internet and wifi facilities.
- You may also enquire at the Department of Classics and World Languages (Theo van Wijk Building, Floor 5) during the conference should you want to access your email.

Nothing planned. Participants have in the past visited the Voortrekker Monument or the Freedom Park, gone shopping in the Brooklyn Mall or Menlyn Park, or even planned a trip to Johannesburg. We'll probably have dinner together as a group at the Brooklyn Square Ocean Basket.

Pilanesberg outing on Sunday

The Pilanesberg Game Reserve is approximately 160 km to the northwest of Pretoria, at least a 2 hour drive. Since the animals are early risers and then tend to hide from the sun, we have to leave early on Sunday, 05:00 or thereabouts. Please bear in mind that we are not in control of which animals will show themselves on the day, even though one never leaves the park without having seen some game (and the African veld).

We provide the transport; entrance fee (appr. R30) and lunch at Bakubung are for your account. We will return to Pretoria in time for those who have to catch a plane out on Sunday evening.

Seminar, Monday 25 October

A seminar is provisionally on the cards for Monday morning at Unisa, for those of you who might still be around or those who might find funding more forthcoming should you present two papers on the trip.
